ACCESS MANAGEMENT





RESIDENT COMMUNITY ACCESS

Envera is pleased to provide gate access services for the Del Webb Oak Creek Community. The front gate house will be staffed when the community exceeds 100 closed homes. Until that time the Virtual service will monitor the gates in the community after 7:00 p.m. which are subject to change.

Guard House: To be announced when the gate house is staffed Resident Services and 24/hr. Envera hotline: 877.936.8372

Upon closing you will receive your community access devices. Two window stickers for your vehicles and two fobs for future Amenity access and pedestrian access. Please place the window stickers in the upper right corner of the inside of your windshield (passenger side) and utilize the resident lane to access the community.

If you are in a vehicle without your windshield sticker (such as a rental car), you can enter the property by using the kiosk in the same manner as a visitor. All residents are entered in the community database so the monitoring center will recognize you as a resident by your driver's license.

VISITOR COMMUNITY ACCESS

Envera has installed a kiosk that provides virtual guard services.

- Visitors will pull their vehicle alongside the kiosk and will push an intercom button, place their driver's license into the kiosk and an operator at the center will grant them access after viewing their license.
- You will receive a welcome e-mail sometime after closing on your home with instructions and your personal login credentials. These credentials can be changed upon logging in the first time.
- There is a web-based version and an app you can download on your mobile device called MyEnvera. The web version is where you can manage your account, the app is for quick additions to your guest list.
- Residents will enter both permanent and temporary visitors into the visitor management software. They will have the option of providing permanent guests immediate access by entering their license plate.
- If a visitor is not listed on a resident's guest list, the guard will call the resident for clearance.

Any owner who transfers occupancy of their home suspends their rights to these community aspects. The qualified occupant shall be entitled to these community aspects.
